## What Projects Require AA Approval (1 of 3)?

- All Roofing Replacements
  - Filings 1 & 2 (Lower Portion Windjammer)
  - Filings 3 & 4 (Upper Portion; Upgraded Shingles)
- Changes in Landscaping (Visible from Street)
  - Changed Design
  - New Lawn Ornamentation (e.g. Windmill)
  - Tree and Shrub Planting (or Removal)
  - New Concrete, Bricks, or Rock
  - Artificial Turf (Allowed; But High Quality Install)
  - Note: Front Lawns Require 35% Greenery on Surface

## What Projects Require AA Approval (2 of 3)?

- Changes in Exterior Paint Color
- All Windows, Doors, and Garage Doors
  - Normally AA Requests Full Window Replacement
    - If Different Product/Design
- Temporary Trash Dumpsters
  - Must be in Driveway; Not Street
- Recreational Vehicle Overnight Parking Over 3 Days
  - Can Approve Up to 7 Days
  - Normally in Driveway; Please Don't Block Sidewalk
  - City Code is "No Street;" Homeowner Takes the Risk

## What Projects Require AA Approval (3 of 3)?

- Sheds in 5 Foot (Ft) Side & 7 Ft Rear Utility Easement
  - City Allows up to 8 Ft Height (plus 5 Ft of Roof Peak)
     without a Homeowner Zoning Variance Request
  - Floor Area Limit is 120 Sq Ft without Zoning Variance
  - Homeowner Must Move Shed if the City or Utility Provider Requests Access for Utility Equipment
- Sheds Interior to Yard (Outside Utility Easement)
  - Can be Taller
  - Over 250 Sq Ft Floor Requires County Building Permit
- Shed Color and Shingles to Match House
  - AA Can Approve Variance to Blend in with Neighborhood

# Typical Spring/Summer Approval Numbers

- Landscaping, Tree Removals, & Fence Moves 15
- Home Color Changes 8
- Window, Door, and Deck Changes 5
- Pergola and Patio Covers 4
- Sheds 3
- Paver and Concrete Changes 1
- Gutter Leaf Covers 1
- Roof Shingle Replacements 1
- Temporary Dumpster Emplacement 1
- Note: Other Projects Completed without Approval
  - Homeowners Contacted/Risked Having to Redo

- Covenants Allow the AA 30 Days to Review & Respond
  - Generally Respond in a Week or Less
  - Can Take Longer if have to Ask for Additional Information
